What You Need To Get Started

About This Guide

The quality of the air you and your family breathe every day is a direct result of how often you change your air filter. But before becoming a Member of the Fresh Air Club, it is important for you to know how many filters you have in your home and the sizes of your existing air filters. With that in mind, this simple guide provides information on where to find your filters, how to get the sizes, and then how to sign-up! If there was a "hard part" of becoming a Member of the Fresh Air Club, this would be it. *But Breathe Easy...We'll Take Care of the Rest!*



It's Your Environment!

Find Your Filter

Many air conditioner or furnace filters are located at air return vents or intake grates in your home, where the air flows into the wall or ceiling. These look like large vents, but air flows into them and not out of them, for circulation of air through the system. Which means you and your family are breathing re-circulated air! Some systems are sometimes filtered at the unit, typically on the intake side of the furnace (This system would be located in a basement or closet). There will be a filter door that allows the filter to slide into the slot that holds the filter.

Many homes have more than one air filter grate (the most common is two) and are often different sizes. Please make sure you get the sizes for each filter you need for your home.

Getting The Right Size

The measurements of your filter size are usually printed on the cardboard edge of the filter currently in your system. The measurements are usually indicated in Width X Length X Height (for example 16 X 30 X 1). You may have to pull out the filter to see the writing, so be careful when doing so. You want to avoid loosening any of the debris, dander, or dust mites trapped in the filter. Write down the measurements of each filter on this form in the space provided. Be sure to put the current filter back in place until we have shipped you a clean one to replace it.

What If I Need To Measure the Filter?

If the measurements are not located on the edge of the filter, you can use the measuring tape and measure the filter in inches. Write down the measurements on this form below in the space provided. When going through the sign-up process, choose one of the size filters that is closest to your measurements. (NOTE: The actual dimensions of the filter may be a little smaller, perhaps as much as ½" an inch smaller in both directions.)

What If There Is No Filter Currently in My System?

If there is no filter to measure, find the track that the air filter would normally fit into. Measure the inside of the track and compare that measurement to our filter sizes in the drop down menus provided in sign-up process. Pick the air filter size that will fit your central air conditioner / furnace. Choose the actual size that is up to ½" smaller than the length and width you measured so that the air filter fits in the track.
